



Position: Licensed Therapist & Clinical Educator (LCPC/LCSW)
(Spanish Speaking Preferred, not required)

Supervisor: Director of Client Services

The Therapist & Clinical Educator is responsible for providing crisis, individual, and group counseling services to children, adolescents, and adult survivors of sexual abuse/assault and their non-offending significant others. The Therapist & Clinical Educator is responsible for providing clinical training and information as it relates to clinical support for survivors of sexual assault/sexual abuse to the professional community. The following is a list of duties, which are considered essential functions of this job. This list is not exhaustive, as all positions at Zacharias Sexual Abuse Center (ZCenter) are dynamic. This is consistent with our need to be flexible and responsive to the needs of the agency.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Provide trauma-based, client-centered, individual counseling and/or support groups for child, adolescent, and adult survivors of sexual assault and abuse.
- Provide trauma-based, client-centered, individual counseling and/or support groups for non-offending parents/caregivers of child survivors.
- Coordinate and provide clinical training and education as it relates to sexual assault/sexual abuse to the professional community (i.e. clinicians, social workers, first responders, etc.).
- Collaborate with the Clinical Team and the Prevention Team in order to develop and facilitate clinical education trainings that meet the needs of the community.
- Facilitate a portion of the 40-hour volunteer / staff training as needed.
- Actively participate in clinical staff meetings and individual supervision for case consultation.
- Maintain a flexible schedule, including ability to work 2-3 evenings a week.

Qualifications:

- Master's level degree in Counseling or Social Work.
- Licensed Clinical Professional Counselor or Licensed Clinical Social Worker
- Completion of 40-hour Sexual Assault Crisis Intervention Training (provided by ZCenter)
- Experience with trauma based Client-Centered counseling
- Experience in the field of sexual assault and abuse.
- **Fluent in Spanish, preferred but not required.**
- **Cover Letter and 2 references required to be considered for the position.**
