

HUMAN TRAFFICKING STATISTICS

51,919

Human trafficking cases have been reported to the National Human Trafficking Resource Center between 2007 and 2018.



7,859

Trafficking cases were reported in 2018 alone.

22,326 survivors identified in 2019

Trafficking :

Trafficking uses fear, coercion, or threats such as violence or withholding pay, usually for the trafficker's personal gain.

While transportation may be involved, it is not required to be considered trafficking.

MALE VS FEMALE TRAFFICKERS

A majority of traffickers are male, but 15-32% are female.

AVERAGE AGE OF VICTIMS

11-14: 30% of victims are children.

Only **.04%** of survivors are identified!

PROSECUTIONS

U.S. attorneys prosecuted **1,049** suspects for human trafficking offenses in 2015. This was a **44** percent increase from the 729 suspects prosecuted in 2011.

In fiscal year 2015, **1,923** suspects were referred to U.S. attorneys with human trafficking as the lead charge
