

# SEXUAL ABUSE STATISTICS

## MILITARY

14,900 military members experienced unwanted sexual contact in the fiscal year ending September, 2016.

Estimated prevalence of sexual assault of women in the U.S. military increased to 6.2% from 4.3% in 2016, according to the Pentagon's annual study. Prevalence rates for men remain unchanged at 0.7%.

52% of women reported retaliation – social or professional – after reporting a sexual assault.

## INMATES

Allegations of sexual victimization in adult correctional facilities nearly tripled from 2011 to 2015.

Correctional administrators reported 24,661 allegations of sexual victimization in prisons, jails, and other adult correctional facilities in 2015.

60% of all sexual violence against inmates is perpetrated by jail or prison staff.

## COLLEGE AGE

Nearly two thirds of college students experience sexual harassment. According to a 2019 Campus Climate Survey, nonconsensual sexual contact by physical force or inability to consent since enrollment was 13%.

### Women

In 2019, a Campus Climate Survey found that at 33 of the nation's major universities was almost one in four undergrad women.

### Men

15% of college men are victims of forced sex during their time in college

### LGBTQ+

21% of TGQN (transgender, genderqueer, nonconforming) students have been sexually assaulted.
