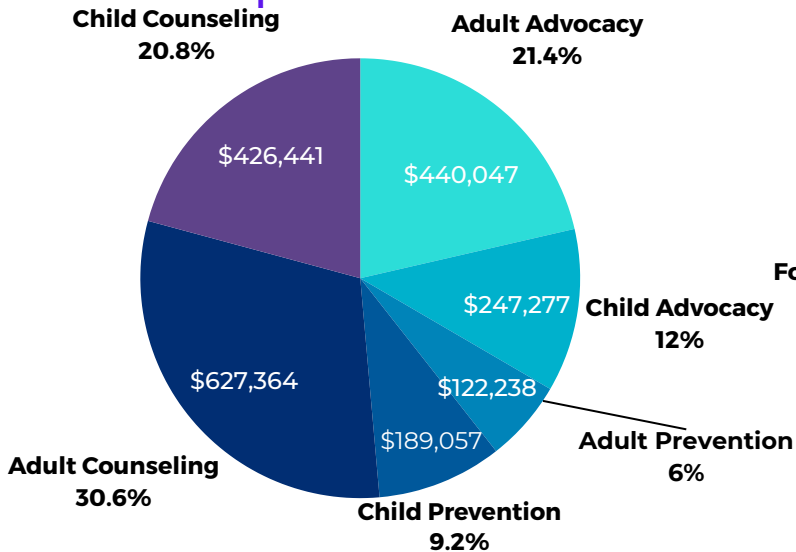

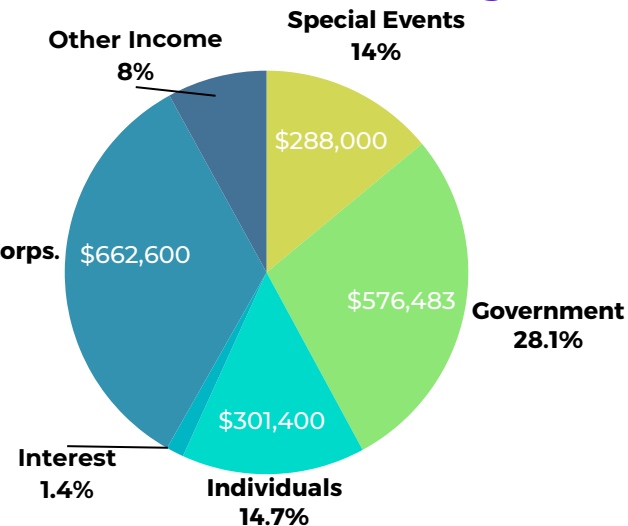

## IMPACT 100 GRANT AWARD



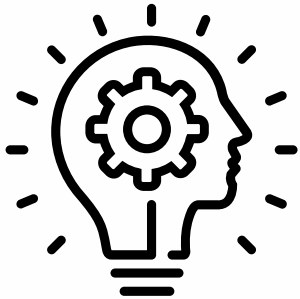
